

The evaluation of DBSA funded projects in the water and sanitation sector: Case study Ceres Bulk Water Augmentation Scheme.

The study assessed the performance and development results of the Ceres Bulk Water Augmentation Scheme aimed at the role of the Witzenberg Municipality and the Koekedouw Irrigation Board and facilitating sustainable water demand management. The study generated findings and recommendations related to water management and the funding of water infrastructure to guide DBSA in financing similar projects or follow-on projects. Information were obtained to assist the DBSA to develop new and innovative products and services for the municipal water, geographic integration and infrastructure sector.

Thus, this review assessed the relevance, appropriateness, cost-effectiveness and sustainability of the programme/project and the appropriateness of the DBSA funding.
